

Family Visitation Guidelines

Help us minimize the spread of COVID-19.

The following are Family Visitation Guidelines designed to respond to the Re-Open Saskatchewan plan, improve mental health and minimize exposure for our tenants, staff, partners and community to avoid the spread of the coronavirus:

- As of June 15th up to 2 members of tenants extended household family at a time will be able to visit tenants in their unit **ONLY** while maintaining a social distance of 2m (6 feet).
- Buildings with an outdoor patio tenants are encouraged to use outdoor patios when possible to visit with up to 2 members of extended household family at a time, **ONLY** if proper social distancing can be maintained.
- Serving food or drinks to your visitors or visitors bringing in food or drinks prepared in a residential kitchen is discouraged.
- All visitors must continue to sign in when entering the building and answer screening questions about their health. See the **Screening Checklist** provided in this package.
- Visits from children under the age of 16 is also discouraged. Children do not necessarily show symptoms of COVID-19; therefore, they could pose an unknown risk to the health of tenants and staff.
- Family visitors should not be interacting with multiple tenants.
- Tenants and family visitors should remember to wash and sanitize their hands before re-entering the building.
